Introduction:

COMMUNITY BENEFIT NARRATIVE REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS

The Maryland Health Services Cost Review Commission's (HSCRC's or Commission's) Community Benefit Report, required under §19-303 of the Health General Article, Maryland Annotated Code, is the Commission's method of implementing a law that addresses the growing interest in understanding the types and scope of community benefit activities conducted by Maryland's nonprofit hospitals.

The Commission developed a two-part community benefit reporting system that includes an inventory spreadsheet that collects financial and quantitative information and a narrative report to strengthen and supplement the inventory spreadsheet. The guidelines and inventory spreadsheet were guided, in part, by the VHA, CHA, and others' community benefit reporting experience, and was then tailored to fit Maryland's unique regulatory environment. This reporting tool serves as the narrative report. The instructions and process for completing the inventory spreadsheet remain the same as in prior years. The narrative is focused on (1) the general demographics of the hospital community, (2) how hospitals determined the needs of the communities they serve, (3) hospital community benefit administration, and (4) community benefit external collaboration to develop and implement community benefit initiatives.

The Commission moved to an online reporting format beginning with the FY 2018 reports. In this new template, responses are now mandatory unless marked as optional. If you submit a report without responding to each question, your report may be rejected. You would then be required to fill in the missing answers before resubmitting. Questions that require a narrative response have a limit of 20,000 characters. This report need not be completed in one session and can be opened by multiple users.

GBMC employs a nurse practitioner whose sole responsibility is to provide education and primary care services within Towson's low-income senior living facilities. This was a service that had at one time been provided by Baltimore County, but has since been discontinued, allowing GBMC to make an impact on our community health. The primary objective of the initiative is to coordinate care and provide guidance to finding and receiving the appropriate healthcare resources for the targeted low-income senior population. In addition to helping the target population locate appropriate resources, direct care is provided to patients on a temporary basis until they have been able to establish a primary care provider. Additionally, this initiative is supported by the Elder Medical Care Program that includes home-based services such as lab services, behavioral health consultations, community health coordination, and interventions by pharmacists on a case-by-case basis. This enables an interdisciplinary team to provide even more clinical interventions in the home setting.

Throughout FY 19 our nurse practitioner made 836 visits to seniors throughout the community. During these visits, she provided vaccinations and glucose screenings as a measure for preventive health. Providing these low-income seniors with information regarding their health allows them to make better healthcare decisions. In turn, providing these resources has allowed for better health outcomes including less frequent hospital stays with the reduction in length of stay, resources and waste. For FY 2019, the Elder Medical Care Program delivered home-based services to more than 550 patients. For these patients, there has been a demonstrated reduction in inpatient and ED visits and costs.

This initiative is a collaborative effort with UM St. Joseph and Hungry Harvest. We continue to treat a high volume of bariatric patients through surgical intervention. The obesity management program host an annual reveal party for those patients who have successfully gone through the program. This night is considered a magical, emotional, diverse, community event—where bariatric surgery patients are celebrated and their experience of care is highlighted. Diabetes: The goals of treatment for diabetes are to prevent or delay complications and maintain quality of life. GBMC's SAFE Program Maintain 24/7, 365 days a year Forensic Nurse examiner coverage for victims of all ages. In particular, this year GBMC SAFE has worked to bolster available forensic capacity for the pediatric population. Thank you for submitting Greater Baltimore Medical Center's FY 2019 Community Benefit Narrative Report. Upon reviewing your report, we require clarification of certain issues:

- In response to Question 91 on page 19 of the attached, you indicate that one type of evidence used to determine effectiveness included Other – “Pre-and post- analysis of ED visits and inpatient hospital stays...” Did you intend to select “effects on healthcare utilization or cost?”

Yes, please move “Pre-and post- analysis of ED visits and inpatient hospital stays show these resources have yielded less frequent hospital stays with a reduction in LOS, resources and waste” to Effects on healthcare utilization or cost.

- In response to Question 111 on page 22, you provide responses for outcomes of the Obesity/Diabetes initiative that appear to fall outside of FY 2019. Please clarify and provide a response for any outcomes observed during FY 2019.

Question 110:

The annual reveal party has yielded hundreds of new patient visits going into the following year. With each successful event the attendance has increased for each year (2017-750 attendees, 2018-1,300 attendees and 2019-1,700 with 2,000 expected attendees for 2020). Produce in a SNAP has become a staple event at GBMC, with plans to expand more markets at UM St. Joseph and other sites in 2020.

Question 111:

The annual reveal party produced 106 new patients in 2017, 164 new patients in January 2018 and 117 new patients in January 2019 which equates to about 84 pounds in weight loss per patient. The estimated total weight loss for the 2019 reveal party was 110,000 pounds. The Produce in a SNAP initiative has added to our programs that are targeting those individuals who have food insecurity, obesity and diabetes. The promotion alone throughout Baltimore County has brought patients and community member a healthy and nutritious alternative to promote wellness and health living.
