Re: Maryland Hospital Acquired Conditions (MHAC) Final Rankings and Scaling Results

This memorandum is to inform hospitals that Health Services Cost and Review Commission (HSCRC) will be using the results below for the Maryland Hospital Acquired Conditions Program (MHAC) revenue adjustments for Rate Year (RY) 2016. The RY2016 MHAC results for attainment and improvement used base period data from calendar year 2013 and performance period data from calendar year 2014.

Scaling was determined based on preset values calculated using the base period attainment scores (see Appendix I). The statewide improvement in the all-payer risk-adjusted complications rate was 26.26%, which exceeded the statewide minimum improvement target of 8% and thus the present scale with a maximum of 1% at-risk and up to 1% rewards was used. The Commission voted in March of 2015 to have the RY2016 rewards and penalties not be revenue neutral. In total, the penalties are \$1,080,406 and rewards are \$7,869,585 for RY2016. Appendix II shows the individual hospital scores and revenue impact.
