Re: Change in Standard Unit of Measure for Emergency Services Provided at Free Standing Medical Facilities

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide notice of a change in the standard unit of measure for emergency services provided at Free Standing Medical Facilities (FMFs). This guidance only affects the facilities currently utilizing the FSE rate center and reporting units as visits in that center.

FMFs should immediately begin utilizing relative value units (RVUs) rather than visits as the standard unit of measure for billing and reporting emergency services. Going forward, FMFs should report emergency services volumes and revenues under the EMG rate center.

The appropriate changes will be made to the HSCRC Accounting and & Budget Manual to recognize this change.
